A cardiologist and social media personality, Ong is giving the Senate another shot after an unsuccessful bid in 2019 to push for health reforms even while battling with cancer.

Stance on Key Issues

On Poverty, Controlling Inflation and Jobs

- Calls on PhilHealth to provide free angiogram and chemotherapy for cancer patients; angiogram, angioplasty, heart bypass, CT scan, MRI, and PET scans for all members
- · Favors regulation of agricultural imports to support local farmers and fisherfolk
- Has pushed for more jobs and infrastructure development in the Visayas and Mindanao to balance the country's overall economy
- Supports revision of the Constitution to allow foreigners to own or rent land as a means of boosting foreign direct investments

On Fighting Graft and Corruption

- Supports a rule preventing members of political dynasties to serve consecutive terms in elected government positions, saying the root cause of corruption are candidates who receive funding from wealthy benefactors
- Proposes to allow only two or three family members of a political dynasty to simultaneously serve in government positions
- Proposes measures to curb corruption, including the computerization of data from PhilHealth, Bureau of Internal Revenue and Bureau of Customs; full disclosure of the Statement of Assets and Liabilities of public officials; and the creation of expenditure roadmaps/line items for congressmen's projects

On The Drug War

- Says the criminal justice approach is not the best way to carry out the campaign against against drug addiction, a public health issue rooted in the lack of proper rehabilitation and prevention
- Favors arresting drug pushers, saying users are victims of depression who need intervention
- Calls for the provision of more antidepressants / medicines and intervention of psychologists, psychiatrists and social workers in fighting drug addiction

On Disaster-preparedness

 Urges the public to secure stocks of potassium iodide and build fallout shelters since the Philippines is unprepared for a nuclear attack

Issues and Controversies

- During the 2022 presidential election, Ong was forced to skip a campaign in Mindanao after his political party, Aksyon Demokratiko, said the region already had a preferred candidate and did not want him to "lose face." He said he was hurt by the decision.
- Ong clarified in May 2024 that he was not the Willie Ong, a suspected Chinese drug lord and owner of Empire 999 Realty Corporation, investigated for the seizure of some 530 kilos of shabu worth P3.6 million in September 2023.
- Social media posts falsely claimed he is the biological father of businesswoman
 Cassandra Ong, linked to an illegal online gambling operator in Porac, Pampanga.
