Issues and Controversies

- Gained notoriety for publicly scolding members of his staff and co-hosts, even going on long rants and diatribes against critics before a live audience
- Embroiled in a 13-year legal battle with ABS-CBN Corp. over an alleged breach of contract due to copyright infringement of a show. In 2023, the Supreme Court ruled in his favor and junked the network's P1-billion counterclaim based on a previous ruling that found the company guilty of "forum shopping."
